

## **Coordination with Grants and Allocations**

Recently Plainfield Community Consolidated School District #202 has supported the uses of technology with funding from several grants:

**Title II** funds have allowed us to send teachers to Math and Science workshops to learn not only new teaching techniques, but to learn about the Illinois State Learning Standards and how they apply to the classroom teacher.

**Title V** funds are allocated annually for the purchase of technology hardware/software, print resources and equipment.

**Foundation for Excellence Mini-Grant Program** awards individual teachers \$500 to support instructional initiatives, including technology.

**Campus Grants** (up to \$2,500.00) are available annually to improve instruction and learning.

**Riverboat Monies and matching Board of Education funds** are distributed on a per pupil basis to each building and designated for technology purchases within that building. This amount varies yearly based upon profits.
