

Athletic Registration Information

(Freshman)

Dear Freshman Parent:

As an incoming freshman, students are required to have a physical turned in to Plainfield North High School. This physical can also be used as a sports physical if the student is interested in participating in athletic activities; however, a copy of this physical also needs to be turned into the athletic office. For athletics a physical is good for one year, from the date it is given.

In addition to turning in the freshman physical, when registering for a sport, the "IHSA Steroid Testing Policy Consent to Random Testing" form must also be turned in. Student-Athletes also need to turn in an Athletic Code of Conduct, which is signed by parents and students and a yellow emergency contact card. Both of these items will be available in the athletic office in August 2008.
