



What is it?

Discovery Education produces and distributes high-quality digital video content in easy-to-use formats in all core-curricular subject areas.

How can it be used?

From the Media Center, students should click on the *United Streaming* link found under the Databases page. The link will take you to the home page for Discovery Education's UnitedStreaming. Off to the right, you will notice the log in area. You will need the following information.

Username: plainfield

Password: tigers

How can information be found?

1. Using the *search* button at the top of the page, type in the topic that you have been assigned.
2. If at that point you click on the *go* button found to the right, UnitedStreaming will search all types of media that it offers.
3. Once you find a "Full Video" that perhaps will fit your topic, click on the grey *segment* link found at the bottom of the annotation. This will give you a list of segments and will allow you to narrow down your search.
4. This will bring up a list of "Full Video" and "Video Segments."
5. You will notice these two tabs at the top of your list. Scroll down the list until you find a possible video segment that fits your topic.
6. To the left you notice a green arrow (which will allow you to play) and a blue box (which will allow you to download the clip).
7. You can download your clips into your network folder, so you can create a link through PowerPoint™ into your presentation.

How can this information be cited?

When you search a list, one of the other tabs at the top, besides "Full Video" and "Video Segments," will state *Citations*. If you click on this tab, the citation will be listed already in MLA format. ☺ No extra charge for that service!
