Dear AP Student and Family,

The College Board Advanced Placement Examinations will be given starting on May 7, 2012 through May 25, 2012. As a student who is enrolled in at least one AP course at PNHS, I encourage you to consider taking the AP Examination(s) in the area(s) which you have studied this year. By taking AP Courses and AP Exams, you have the opportunity to earn credit, advanced placement, or both for college.

I have included the **2011-12 Bulletin for AP Students and Parents** with this invitation letter, which lists the dates and times for AP Examinations. (Dates and times can be found on the back cover.) Please note that the testing administration dates and times are determined by the College Board. Tests that start at 12:00 pm will most likely run longer than a normal school day and transportation will be the responsibility of the student. Information on testing accommodations for students that have a documented disability can be found on page 7. Requests must be received by College Board no later than February 24, 2012.

The cost for each AP Exam is \$87. To register for an AP Exam, please complete the registration form attached. If a student is planning on taking two or more exams the back side of the form needs to be completed. If you have two AP Exams that are on the same date and time, or three or more AP Exams on the same date you will need to take a late exam. Late exams fall on the last three days of school when students may be taking final exams, so morning exams on these days may be a conflict with finals, so please keep that in mind when deciding which late exam you chose. Registrations with payment should be returned to Mrs. Tjernagel in the attendance office. She can also answer questions you may have about registering for the exams. Financial assistance may be available for qualified students. Information regarding financial assistance can be found on page 2 in the bulletin. **Registration deadline is March 26, 2012.**
