Have a wonderful, safe summer! Good luck in second grade!

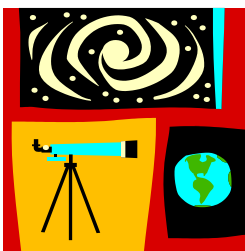
This Week In 1st Grade...
