Driver- The club usually used when a golfer tees off on the first shot of the hole.

Putter- This club is used only on the green, usually the last shot before the ball is put in the hole.

Irons- These clubs are used on the fairway or the rough. Golfers use these to get the ball on the green so they can putt.

Slice- When a golfer hits the ball and it curves away from the golfer as it goes down the fairway.

Hook- When a golfer hits the ball and it curves toward the side of the ball the golfer was standing on when they hit it.

Tee Box- This is the only place a golfer may use a tee when hitting, only on their first shot.

Par- The number of shots it is supposed to take a golfer to get the ball in the cup on a certain hole. There is also a par for the course.

Birdie- When a golfer is one under par for a hole.

Bogey- When a golfer is one over par for a hole.
