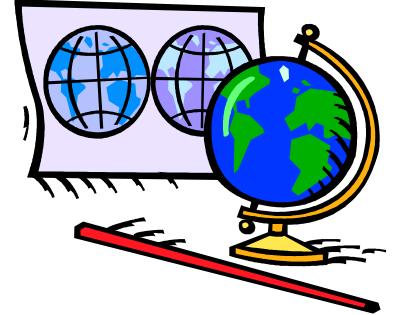


# Mrs. Ready's 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Social Studies Class

3<sup>rd</sup> time – The action will be recorded and the student will have to serve an after-school detention from 2:35 – 3:05. If the issued detention is not served, the student will be issued a second detention from 2:35 – 3:30. If the second issued detention is not served, the student will be referred to the Dean of Students.

**Expectations for Assignments:**

**Missing Assignments:**

If a student does not turn in an assignment on the due date, 10% will be deducted for each day it is late. He/She may also be required to attend Afterschool STARS from 2:40 to 3:30. This is an afterschool homework help program.

**Absence:**

A student that is absent has one day for each day absent in order to make up his/her work. It is the student's responsibility to check what work has been missed while being absent.

**Extra Credit:**

Every student has an opportunity to complete up to four extra credit assignments per quarter. Extra credit is awarded if a student brings a copy of a newspaper, magazine, or internet article about a current event along with a well-developed, one-page summary in his or her own words of the article. Each assignment is worth an extra five points that will be added to the homework portion of the grade.
