

6th Grade Discipline Program

- Any three offenses of the following rules, one or combination, will result in a detention before or after school.
 - 1) Coming to class unprepared (lack of daily supplies)
 - 2) Tardiness
 - 3) Gum/Candy/Etc...chewing in class
 - 4) Disrespecting others
 - 5) Not following basic classroom/hallway rules

- Students that do not serve the administered detention from 2:31-3:00 p.m. will be required to serve a detention from 2:31-3:30 p.m. If the student does not serve the 2:31-3:30 p.m., detention will then be referred to the Dean of Students.

- Teachers reserve the right, without warning, to issue a detention, restrict individual(s) from field trips/assemblies, or refer a student to the Dean of Students for serious offenses.



SUBSTITUTE TEACHER POLICY:

If a student's name is identified for any negative reason while in the presence of a substitute teacher, a minimum one-hour detention will be issued to be served by the student.
