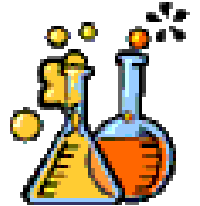


Mrs. Ready's 6th Grade Science Class

What happens if I am not being responsible?

(Level 1 Infraction as stated in the handbook along with classroom responsibilities)

1st and 2nd time – The student will be warned and the action recorded

3rd time – The action will be recorded and the student will have to serve an after-school detention from 2:35 – 3:05. If the issued detention is not served, the student will be issued a second detention from 2:35 – 3:30. If the second issued detention is not served, the student will be referred to the Dean of Students.

How am I graded?

The Science grade will be determined through a variety of assessments. Grading criteria includes, but is not limited to, homework, quizzes, tests, projects, group activities and writing assignments.

Expectations for Assignments:

Students are always expected to complete assignments with 100% effort. Assignments should begin with the following information in the top right corner of the paper if no other heading is provided:

DATE

CLASS PERIOD

ASSIGNMENT

Missing Assignments:

If a student does not turn in an assignment on the due date, 10% will be deducted for each day it is late. He/She may also be required to attend Afterschool STARS from 2:40 to 3:30. This is an afterschool homework help program.

Absence:

A student that is absent has one day for each day absent in order to make up his/her work. It is the student's responsibility to check what work has been missed while being absent.

Extra Credit:

Every student has an opportunity to complete up to four extra credit assignments per quarter. Extra credit is awarded if a student brings a copy of a newspaper, magazine, or internet article about a current event in the scientific community along with a well-developed, one-page summary in his or her own words of the article. Each assignment is worth an extra five points that will be added to the homework portion of the grade.
