## **Tournament Rules:**

- 1.) 5 Woman Team
- 2.) Substitution at the end of games only.
- 3.) If bowler is removed in middle of a game for injury, they can not return.
- 4.) Switch Lanes after each game – NEW THIS YEAR.
- 5.) 2<sup>ND</sup> round placement made according to 1<sup>st</sup> round finish
- 6.) 5 bowlers and 2 coaches allowed in lower level.
- 7.) Super Sub Competition – 2 bowlers per team – 3 games  
Super sub bowlers are eligible to bowl in afternoon

**4 Divisions :** After the morning round, teams will be divided into **4** divisions ( Gold, Silver, Bronze, Copper ). Top 12 Gold, 13-24 Silver, 25-36 Bronze, 37-44 Copper

**Awards:** Team Awards – Gold 1<sup>st</sup> thru 5<sup>th</sup>, Silver 1<sup>st</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup>, Bronze & Copper 1<sup>st</sup>  
**Individual Awards:** 1<sup>st</sup> thru 25<sup>th</sup>  
**Super Sub Awards:** 1<sup>st</sup> thru 10<sup>th</sup>.

**BOTTOM 2 TEAMS:** May not be offered contracts in 2010 if under 4800 for 6 games.

Dear Coach,

December is coming which means it is time for the best girls bowling tournament around. We will have 44 outstanding teams from all over the state of Illinois. The tournament format is a 6 game tournament but after the morning round I will divide the field into four ( 4 ) divisions, Gold, Silver, Bronze, Copper This will be done to give more teams a chance to win team awards in this event. We want you to compete hard all day, even if your morning was not what you expected. We are excited to announce the addition of Peotone High School and Rockford Auburn High School this year. They will make this event even stronger. The super Sub competition will also continue. This is a concept I started many years ago to give more girls a chance to compete in this great event, and to give you a chance to look at more girls, to see if you want to make any changes to your line-up in the afternoon. This is done during the lunch break and each school can enter 2 girls. This is not mandatory, but your girls will enjoy it. A girl is only eligible if she did not bowl in the morning. Those girls though can compete for your team in the afternoon. Their scores in the super sub do NOT count towards your team score.

**NEW LAST YEAR:** Teams will switch lanes after each game and teams will be put in blocks of 6. This is done to prepare you for the state series. Please check your lane assignments. Substitutions can also be made after any GAME. If a girl is subbed out after a game, she can come back the next game. There will be no substitutions in the middle of a game. Also, we are having our programs professionally made so when the company contacts you, please send them a picture immediately.

This year we will again give each team 7 bowling towels with the tournament logo and teams entered listed. The girls really enjoy these, and keep them as souvenirs. A few extra will be for sale for your other bowlers and fans.

**LUNCH** – This year lunch will be the same as the past. We will have a buffet type lunch with either turkey or ham sandwich, provided by our bowling parents.

**COACHES LUNCHES ARE PROVIDED FREE OF CHARGE!** This is my way of saying thank you for coming and working so hard with your team to help make this event a great success. There are many fast food restaurants in the area and **FOOD CAN NOT BE BROUGHT IN!**

**SEATING** – Please advise parents that bleachers are being brought in, but it will not be enough and space will be limited. Doors open at 8:00, and I suggest they be there at 8:00 to get a good seat.

## **Directions to Town & Country lanes:**

### **From Chicago Suburbs or Southern Illinois:**

**I-55 to Rt. 52 ( Joliet / Shorewood ) Exit No. 253. Take Rt. 52 east 2 miles to Springfield Ave. Turn left, bowling alley on right one half block. You will pass the airport, Joliet Stadium, and Menards, ( all on the right ), cross over tracks before your turn on Springfield.**

### **From Rockford Area:**

**I - 39 South to I-80 east to I-55 north. I-55 to Rt. 52 ( Joliet / Shorewood ) Exit No. 253. Take Rt. 52 east 2 miles to Springfield Ave. Turn left, bowling alley on right one half block. You will pass the airport, Joliet Stadium, and Menards, ( all on the right ), cross over tracks before your turn on Springfield.**

### **From Southern Suburbs**

**I-80 west to Larkin Ave. in Joliet. Go north on Larkin to Jefferson St. ( Rt. 52 ). Turn left and go to Springfield Ave. ( 1 mile ) and turn right. Bowling alley on right.**

### **From the Aurora Area:**

**Take Rt. 30 east to I-55 south. I-55 to Rt. 52 ( Joliet / Shorewood ) Exit No. 253. Take Rt. 52 east 2 miles to Springfield Ave. Turn left, bowling alley on right one half block. You will pass the airport, Joliet Stadium, and Menards, ( all on the right ), cross over tracks before your turn on Springfield.**
