Sportsmanship

- Profane language will not be tolerated
- Abuse of equipment will not be tolerated
- Improper conduct towards opposing teams will not be tolerated
- Respect for coaches will be shown at all times
- We are representing Plainfield North, as such respect will be demonstrated at all times

Consequences

- Verbal warning for first offense
- No participation for next meet
- 1 week suspension with letter home to parents
- Release from team

Attendance

You will need to contact Coach Garee, Coach Kedz, Coach Lear or Mr. Johnson if there is a reason you will not be at a meet or practice. Even if you are sick during the day, we need to know this. Another player telling us will not suffice. You are required to be in the last 4 periods of the school day in order to participate in the meet.

Unexcused Absences

- 1st offense: Verbal warning given
- 2nd offense: 1 meet suspension
- 3rd offense: 3 meet suspension
- 4th offense: release from team

Tardiness

Since some of our athletes will be transporting themselves to the practices, the following tardy policies will be adopted

- 1st tardy: verbal warning
- 2nd tardy: note home to parents
- 3rd tardy: 1 meet suspension
- 4th tardy: loss of driving privilege
- 5th tardy: release from team

Athletic Code Violations

Those disciplined for athletic code violations (drinking, caught at party, illicit photos on internet) will face up to an additional two meet suspension

Lost and Found equipment

- If any personal equipment is left out and found by the coaching staff, a 1 sports drink per coach will be given to the coaches at the next practice. (Coach Garee prefers chocolate)
- If bowling area or bus is left in an unacceptable condition (shoes not returned, cups left on lanes, etc) parties responsible will be staying afterwards to clean area and/or bus.
- If any school equipment is lost or damaged beyond repair, the party it was assigned to will be paying the replacement cost.

Dress code

- All players are expected to be dressed appropriately before boarding bus for meets. See consequences for reprisals.
- Failure to wear practice shirt will result in a \$2.00 fine and athlete will wear replacement shirt for remainder of practice.
- Failure to bring equipment to meet will result in player's inability to compete in that meet.
- No hats on bus ride to/from meets.
