

# SWIMMER OF THE WEEK

**10/15 – 10/21 Zangelica Chaffee** – For her performance at the Morris Dual meet in which she swam lifetime nests in the 50 and 100 freestyle. Since the beginning of the year Zangelica has lowered her 50 time by 30 seconds!

**10/8 – 10/14 Morgan Corrich** – Is the swimmer of the week for her performance in the 200 IM and 500 Free this past week at our Intra-squad meet. Morgan had time drops of 6 sec. in the IM and 7 sec. in the 500 free.

**10/1 – 10/7 Alexis Schaefer** – For her performance in the Joliet Dual meet, she swam lifetime bests in the 50 fly (200MR) 500 Free, and 100 Free (400FRR). She also placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in the two relays and 500 free along with winning the 50 free.

**9/17 – 9/30 Jorie Wendland** – For her performance in the Oswego East Invite in which she won the JV 200 IM with a Lifetime BT of 2:43.86 as well as her 3<sup>rd</sup> place finish in the JV 500 Fr in which she lowered her time by nearly 30 sec., On Tuesday, in dual meet vs. Osewgo East Jorie swam best times in the 200 IM, 100 Free and 50 Free.

**9/10 – 9/16 Maddie Mikrut** For her performance at the Neuqua Valley Invite in which she placed 4<sup>th</sup> in the 50 free (life time best time) and 5<sup>th</sup> in the 100 fly. She was also a member of the 7<sup>th</sup> place 200 MR and 9<sup>th</sup> place 400 FRR in which she swam a best time 55.29 anchor leg. On Tuesday at Bradley She also swam a lifetime best in the 200 free as well as having four 1<sup>st</sup> place finishes.

**9/1 – 9/9 Brittany Lumb** For her performance in the Fenton Duel, the Porter Relays and the Bremen/Eisenhower Triangular. Brittany swam best times in the 500 free including a 10 sec. drop in the event on Tuesday at Bremen. She also had a 2 sec drop in her 50 fly as well as swimming a best time in the 100 free.
