

PSAE/ACT

WHO WILL BE SCHEUDLED TO TAKE THE PSAE/ACT

All Juniors are required to take the PSAE/ACT and Seniors who have not taken it yet.

DESCRIPTION

The PSAE is a two-day test. On Day 1, Juniors will take the ACT Exam. The ACT is necessary for college admissions and scholarship opportunities. On Day 2 Juniors will take the PSAE WorkKeys Exam.

DURATION OF EXAM

Day 1 (ACT) is approximately 4 hours

Day 2 (PSAE WorkKeys) is approximately 2 hours and 45 minutes

WHERE DO I SIGN UP?

Juniors do not have to sign up for the PSAE/ACT Exam. ALL Juniors and Senior who have not taken it will be automatically registered to take both exams.
