## WHO SHOULD TAKE THE SAT?

Most students take the SAT during their junior or early senior year of high school, and many colleges and universities use the SAT to make admission decisions.

## DESCRIPTION

The SAT and SAT Subject Tests are a suite of tools designed to assess your academic readiness for college. There is the SAT reasoning test which includes reading, writing and math and separate SAT Subject Tests. Students should check with colleges and universities to see what they require. These exams provide a path to opportunities, financial support and scholarships, in a way that's fair to all students. The SAT and SAT Subject Tests keep pace with what colleges are looking for today, measuring the skills required for success in the 21st century.

SAT Subject Tests – 1 hour per test
