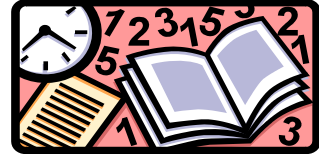

QUIZZES/TESTS

- **Unexcused Absence** - If your absence is unexcused you will be given no credit for the days assignments missed. If you are unexcused for a test or quiz 25% of your score will be deducted from your assessment.
- **Quiz Corrections** - If you are unhappy with the score of a quiz you have the option to make corrections to that quiz for homework. Corrections can only be made on problems that were attempted on the original quiz. In order to receive up to half the credit back you must show correct and completed work with at least one sentence stating the mistake you made on the original quiz.
- **Test Retakes** – If you are unhappy with the score of a test you may retake that test within one week of receiving the score for that test. In order to do so you must make at least one appearance in the learning lab for help or come to me for help (before or after school) on that test and then you will be allowed to retake it. If you retake a test you will be given the retake score, for better or for worse.
