Under Water

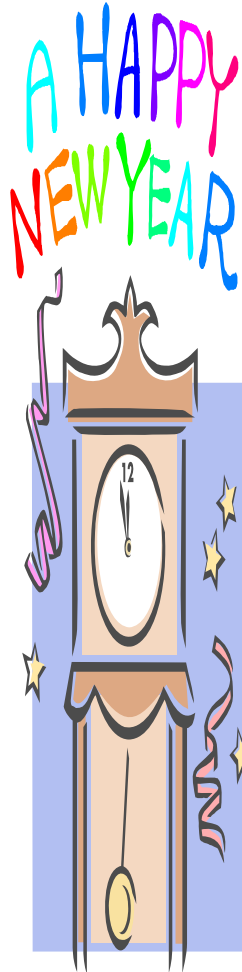
Assorted ocean and manatee books
